Covenant Issues Needing Attention

We are all bound to our community's covenants, please review the following "hot" issues.

- IT'S SPRING TIME!!!: Please treat your lawn with weed killer and keep your grass and weeds cut to 1"-2" so our lawns look consistent and beautiful.
- **Dogs:** Please maintain dogs on a leash. Also, when walking dogs, please ensure all dog feces is cleaned up and properly disposed of. Please prevent your dogs from constant barking outdoors. If you have issues with loose animals chasing you or harassing you or family members, we encourage you to call Forsyth Animal Code Compliance Directly @ 770-781-2138.
- **Trash Cans:** Trash cans need to be kept concealed from view by neighboring residences and streets.
- Commercial vehicles, trailers, boats and RVs: No commercial vehicles, trailers, RVs, campers, boats or like equipment shall be permitted on any lot within the right-of-way of any street, but is allowed temporarily not to exceed 48 hours. Respectfully, please park all vehicles in your driveway (not on the street). Also, to keep all of our neighbors safe, watch your speed when driving in the neighborhood!
- **Exterior:** Please keep your fence and the exterior of your home looking nice and freshly painted or stained.
- Mailboxes: Part of the maintenance of your property is to ensure the upkeep of mailboxes. Please use flat or satin black spray paint should you need to refresh your current mailbox. If you need a new mailbox or brass numbers, the approved mailbox for Magnolia Creek can be purchased from
